

132. CRITERIA FOR HIRING COACHES POLICY

1. A knowledge of the fundamental skills of the sport and the ability to teach these skills at the level of understanding of the high school student.

2. Experience in working with young people and successfully handle the responsibility of maintaining discipline of a group of young people.

3. Ability to give first aid including C.P.R. and a knowledge of the care and prevention of athletic injuries.

4. A knowledge and understanding of the rules of the sport.

5. An understanding that the purpose of interscholastic athletics is to promote the physical, mental, moral and social well-being of the students.

6. Have demonstrated the ability to act in a sportsmanlike manner in accepting unfavorable decisions from the officials, defeat, and other adverse occurrences encountered in sports.

7. Prior to assuming a coaching position, each individual is required to receive and maintain basic first aid and C.P.R. certification, effective July 1, 1987.
