211. STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE	
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes the need for insurance coverage for unforeseen accidents that may occur to students in the course of attendance at school or participation in the athletic and extracurricular programs of the schools.
2. Authority	<p>The Board shall require parents/guardians of students who participate in an interscholastic sport, cheerleader program, band program and designated extracurricular programs to purchase the student accident insurance available through the school district or provide proof of comparable insurance, prior to the student’s participation.</p> <p>The Board shall provide, at no cost to the Board, parents/guardians the opportunity to purchase insurance coverage for students while participating in an interscholastic sports program; in the cheerleader program; in the band program; in the program of physical education; in any activity in school, on school grounds, on a school bus; at any activity sponsored by the school, including driver education training; while traveling between home and school other than on a school bus; and in any activity round-the-clock.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prepare specifications and secure suitable coverage from qualified insurance carriers. 2.
