223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority SC 779	The Board shall permit the use of bicycles by students in accordance with district administrative regulations, provided that students have been granted permission by the building principal and have obtained parental permission to ride a bicycle to school.
SC 779	The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district administrative regulations, provided that such students are licensed drivers, have followed established procedures and obtained the required permit, and have been granted permission by the building principal to drive a motor vehicle on school grounds.
	The Board prohibits the use of skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, go carts and any other object utilized like the foregoing which conveys or moves on or as if on wheels by persons on school property at any time.
	The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged, or for injuries arising from their use.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The building principal or designee shall disseminate administrative regulations for operating and parking of authorized bicycles and motor vehicles to affected students.
	The building principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules may result in revocation of the permit.
