DRESS AND GROOMING</b></p> <p>Administrative, professional and classified <b>employees set an example in dress and grooming for students and the school community.</b> Employees' dress should reflect their professional status and <b>encourage respect for authority</b> in order to have a <b>positive</b> influence on the <b>district's</b> programs and <b>operations.</b></p> <p><b>The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming requirements, within law, for all district employees to prevent an adverse impact on the educational programs and district operations.</b></p> <p><b>When assigned to district duties, employees shall be physically clean, neat, well-groomed and dressed in a manner consistent with assigned job responsibilities.</b></p> <p><b>If an employee feels that an exception to this policy would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the immediate supervisor.</b></p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
